The summer is almost over and we are ready to have you back-to school!

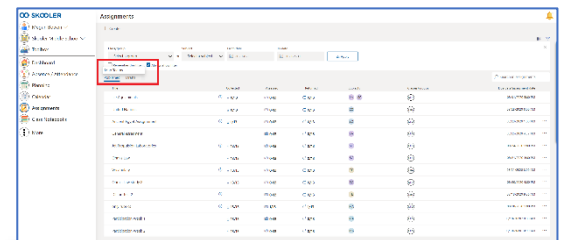
This summer we have been working on some new features and are happy to share that now you can add statewide standards to the Skooler planning tool. When your plan is ready to publish you can easily share with students and parents.

### HYBRID LEARNING

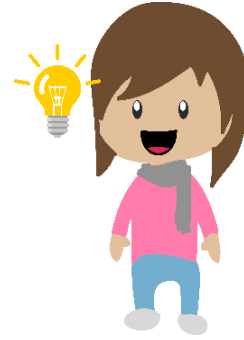
