NEW SKOOLER RELEASE

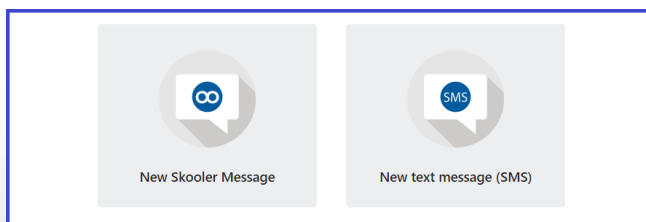
We have several exciting news in this release, as well as having added some bug fixes. We hope you will enjoy the new features.

Send to teacher: Students can submit assignments by choosing the name of the teacher in the assignment tool.

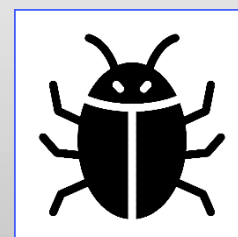


UPDATED

In each release we send out bugfixes. Maybe the bug that has bothered you the most has moved to a new place? -hopefully far away from Skooler🐞

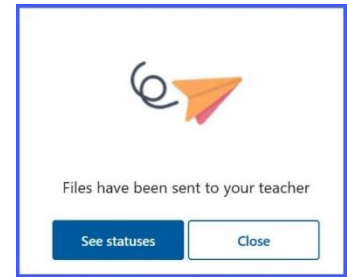


SUBMIT TO TEACHER

Students can now submit directly to their teacher, even though they have no assignment due.

When they use the "Submit to teacher" feature, students get an overview of their teachers. From here, they choose which teacher they want to deliver to; select the file to deliver and press send.

The teachers will receive a notification in the assignment tool that an assignment has been submitted. The teacher can choose to accept or reject the submission.

TOOLBOX

Use 'create groups' to quickly divide students into groups. You choose the number of students who will be in the groups and Skooler provides group suggestions. Give the groups a task to solve within thirty minutes, using the 'timer' feature to show remaining time. When the time is up, choose the 'random student' feature who will present the assignment. When it is time for recess, use the 'School bell' feature to signal a break. These are all suggestions but can be found in the new toolbox tool. The students also have their own toolbox with a 'timer' feature along with a memory game for some fun brain exercise.
