### MESSAGES

#### Registration form and sending out a response form

Within the messaging tool the possibility of creating answer options is back! The setup forms and registration are also improved so that you get more options for inquiries and answers.

You can choose whether those who receive the message should be able to check one or more options. If you want to choose only one option, it will look like this:

If you want more detailed answers, you can opt to use free text responses. It will then look like this:
